YQCA LAUNCHING SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

YQCA is excited to announce the 2025 Scholarship Program available to high school seniors and students enrolled in a 2-4-year university or certification program. In order to be considered for this scholarship, youth must be a high school senior up to 21 years of age. In order to be considered for this scholarship, applicants must:

- Be a high school senior or a high school graduate up to 21 years of age.
- Have an active YQCA certification at the time of application (2025).
- Have had active YQCA certification the previous two years (2023, 2024).

As a high school senior, the essay question regarding future plans to enter the agriculture industry or commitment to a university will be considered for eligibility. Scholarship recipients must provide proof of enrollment to receive the award. High school graduates must be currently enrolled in a 2-4- year university agriculture program or enrolled in a certification program to meet the scholarship requirements. If selected, scholarship funds will be sent directly to the school. Applications open January 1, 2025 and close February 17, 2025. GWEN E. WILSON 4-H SCHOLARSHIP

FRED AND DORIS FINK SCHOLARSHIP

The Fred and Doris Fink Bourbon County 4-H Scholarship will be given during the 2024 Achievement Recognition. This is a \$750.00 scholarship.

Eligibility Requirements are:

- Three or more years in a Bourbon County
- 4-H Club.
- Must demonstrate outstanding achievement in 4-H activities and project work.
- Must be a resident of Bourbon County Kansas.
- Must be a senior in high school or freshman in College.
- Must be used by a student enrolled full time in an accredited Kansas 4-year college or university or a Kansas community college.

Preference will be given to a student in agriculture or family and consumer sciences. Scholarship may be awarded to a previous winner one time. We will use the Kansas 4-H Scholarship Application.
