4-H CLUB NAME	4-H YEAR

Purpose:

Record books allow youth to learn the importance of proper record keeping. It emphasizes accuracy, neatness, leadership, citizenship, and achievement in a single project throughout the 4-H year. Record books show quality and quantity of work in each project while demonstrating the amount of knowledge gained in the project.

The 4-H Council recognizes project achievement at the Annual Achievement Recognition. 4-h youth are ranked by accuracy, neatness, leadership, citizenship, and achievement in each project they are enrolled.

Judging Criteria:

- Some projects are collectively judged with age divisions combined. If all names appear in the Senior Column, then 4 names should be ranked.
- All projects are divided by age groups. Please rank the top 4 from each division.
- Only Senior 4-H members will be allowed to send their project record reports on the area judging.
- Achievement selection should be based on overall accomplishments as a 4-H member during the current 4-H year.

Special Notes:

- Make sure each member turns in an Achievement Pin Application
- The Pin Application should not be attached to the MIG or PRR.
- Leaders are requested to collect Pin Applications and submit them in a folder when the Record Books are submitted.
- Leaders are also requested to look over the Pin Application for accuracy. Make sure both the 4-H member, parent and leaders have signed and dated the application.
- Make sure each member turns in a 4-H Member Seal Summary.
- The 4-H Member Seal Summary should be attached to the front of the MIG.
