

## Royalty Contest Details

The Royalty Contest is a special contest to help raise money for Neosho County 4-H Council to use for special activities and events, such as paying for the camp bus, achievement banquet, etc.

Clubs should select their royalty candidates for the 2024 County Fair. The Extension Office needs your candidate list by **June 21**. Club Leaders, please submit your list by calling 620-244-3826 or emailing [tsolomon@ksu.edu](mailto:tsolomon@ksu.edu).

Responsibilities of candidate:

1. Raise money. This can be your own fundraiser or by putting cans out at local businesses with your picture, club name, and what you are a candidate for on the outside of the can. Make sure that the slot for the money is just big enough to put money through but not big enough to pull money out. Also, make sure to ask permission to place a can at a business.
2. If you choose to put out cans, please ask the business for permission. Make sure the slot for money is just big enough for money to be put into the can and not removed. Also, check the cans regularly. Remove any money collected.
3. Royalty Candidate Questionnaire (located at <https://www.southwind.k-state.edu/fairs/neosho-county/index.html>) is in the Extension Office NO later than **Monday, July 8th**! You may mail to the Erie Office or email to [tsolomon@ksu.edu](mailto:tsolomon@ksu.edu).
4. All **money** must be submitted to the **Extension Office by 4:00 p.m. on Monday, July 22<sup>nd</sup>**, in the form of a check made payable to 4-H Council. It is your responsibility to turn in the money. We will not call to remind you to turn in your money!
5. The candidate with the most money will win the royalty position they were running for. The announcement of winners will be Thursday, July 25<sup>th</sup> at 11:00 a.m. at the show ring arena at the opening ceremony.
6. Winners will be asked to assist with the awards ceremony on Monday night of the County Fair.
